



Case Study: Caleb Mertz – 13-Year-Old Boy with Testicular Pain Patient History

- Chief Complaint: Caleb Mertz, a 13-year-old boy, presents with acute onset testicular pain.
- Symptoms:
 - Severe, sudden pain in the right testicle
 - Nausea and vomiting
 - **o** Mild swelling of the scrotum
 - No fever, dysuria, or urinary frequency
- Onset & Duration: Pain began 3 hours prior while playing soccer.
- Associated Factors: No history of trauma, recent infections, or sexual activity.

Possible Causes

- 1. Testicular Torsion (Most Likely)
 - Twisting of the spermatic cord, leading to ischemia.
