critical thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-An advanced way of thinking, a problemsolving method, and more (anticipate a problem)

knowledge - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-The ability to recall and repeat information you have memorized.

ethics - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-A system of standards or moral principles that direct actions as being right or wrong

What 4 things make up Bloom's Taxonomy? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-
Knowledge, comprehension, application, analysis

What 3 factors influence critical thinking? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-upbringing and culture, motivation, attitude influences thinking

directed thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-purposeful and outcome-oriented (doing a job directly)

Negative thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-the mind is stuck on negative thoughts and blocks worthwhile thinking (emotional sabotage)

Nonfocused thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-you engaged your brain out of habit without much conscious thought (off topic)

What is the western secular belief system? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-Individual autonomy- freedom to choose,

Individual rights- their rights cannot restrict the rights of others (rights of the individuals)

What was the first state to pass a law licensing practical nurses, and when? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-1914, Mississippi

What did Florence Nightingale do? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-went to Crimea with 38 women.

after 6mo the death rate dropped from 420/1000 to 22/1000.

in 1860, she established a training school

What is the definition of morals? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-personal philosophy of right and wrong

What does justice mean? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-Fair to all

What is the definition of comprehension? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-the ability to understand information, recall it, and identify examples.

problem-oriented thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-focus on a particular problem to find a solution
(planning you school, work, and home schedule)

Ruminative thinking - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-the same situation or scene is replayed in your mind over and over without reaching an outcome.
(instant replay)

What was said in italics in chapter 5 - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-Although a very important role, this "critical thinking" really changes our jobs as an LPN

When and where was the first class for formal training of practical nursing? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-1892, YWCA, Brooklyn, New York

Henry Street Settlement - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-one of the best known centers in 1893, Lillian Wald began a nursing service here.

What is the definition of analysis? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-the ability to break down complex information its basic parts and relate those parts to the whole picture.

What is the definition of application? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-the ability to use learned material in new situations.

Colleague reporting - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-Report peers, supervisors, or any team members for behaviors that are potentially harmful to patients

What is ethics concerned with? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-right, wrong, good, bad, ought, duty

What is beneficent paternalism - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-A disrespectful attitude toward the patient and what the patient has to contribute to personal care and recovery.

*Only justified in extreme circumstances)

What does fidelity mean? - ✓✓ANSWER✓✓-Be true
