Chemotherapy - ANSWER>>>Report of sore throat is the priority finding for a client receiving chemotherapy

Systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE) - ANSWER>>>Facial butterfly rash is an expected finding in a client with SLE

Compartment syndrome - ANSWER>>>Pain that increases with passive movement in a client with a short leg cast

Lyme disease - ANSWER>>>Joints ache as a manifestation of severe stage II Lyme disease

Phenytoin - ANSWER>>>Oral solution 125 mg/5 mL, nurse should administer 24 mL for 600 mg

Arterial line - ANSWER>>>Flush line before administering antibiotics

Parathyroidectomy - ANSWER>>>Using pillows to support the client's head and neck is the priority action

Diabetes insipidus - ANSWER>>>Low urine specific gravity is an expected finding in a client with diabetes insipidus

Cervical cancer - ANSWER>>>Implant placed twice each month for the duration of the treatment in stage II cervical cancer

Thoracentesis - ANSWER>>>Instruct the client to remain NPO after midnight prior to the procedure

Blood transfusion - ANSWER>>>Restlessness, dyspnea, and crackles noted to the lung bases indicate a transfusion reaction

Kidney transplant - ANSWER>>>Immunosuppressive therapy is necessary until the donated kidney begins producing urine

Hypothyroidism - ANSWER>>>Constipation is an expected manifestation of hypothyroidism

Mastectomy - ANSWER>>>Referring the client to community resources that can provide support is an appropriate statement for a client scheduled for a mastectomy

Nephrostomy tube - ANSWER>>>The client reporting back pain is an indication of a complication and should be reported to the provider

Alzheimer's disease - ANSWER>>>Position tabletop clocks with multi-colored backgrounds throughout the home for a client with Alzheimer's disease

Pressure injury care - ANSWER>>>Change positions every hour to prevent pressure injuries

Rheumatoid arthritis pain - ANSWER>>>Alternate application of heat and cold to the affected joints can reduce pain

Hemodialysis - ANSWER>>>Restlessness is a priority finding to report to the provider for a client following hemodialysis

Postoperative assessment - ANSWER>>>Extremity cool upon palpation is an indication of decreased circulation and should be reported to the provider

Post-thyroidectomy - ANSWER>>>Temperature 38.9 C (102 F) is a priority finding to report to the provider for a client post-thyroidectomy

Mastectomy drain - ANSWER>>>Instruct the client that the drain will be removed when there is 25 mL of output or less over a 24 hr period

Bone cancer pain - ANSWER>>>A tingling sensation replacing the pain is the effect of applying a TENS unit to the painful area for a client with bone cancer pain

Irritable bowel syndrome - ANSWER>>>Consume at least 30 g of fiber daily to manage constipation in a client with constipation-predominant irritable bowel syndrome

Cancer pain - ANSWER>>>Speaking to the provider about incorporating acupuncture into the treatment plan is an appropriate response for a client with cancer pain

Extubation - ANSWER>>>Stridor is an indication of airway obstruction and should be reported to the provider immediately
